WATER, SEWER, & GARBAGE BILLING

Rates are as follows:

Quarterly

Water	7500 gallons	\$55.00 + 7% tax
	In excess of 7500 gallons	- \$4.75/1000 gallons of usage + 7% tax
Sewer		\$15.00 + \$1.35/1000 gallons of water usage
Sewer Fee		\$3.00 + \$.25/1000 gallons of water usage
Garbage		\$24.00 plus the cost of garbage bags - \$45 Dumpster (Commercial)

Annually

Water	30,000 gallons	\$220.00 + 7% tax
	In excess of 30,000 gallons	- \$4.75/1000 gallons of usage + 7% tax
Sewer		\$60.00 + \$1.35/1000 gallons of water usage
Sewer Fee		\$12.00 + \$.25/1000 gallons of water usage
Garbage		\$96.00 plus the cost of bags - \$180 Dumpster (Commercial)

The City has second meters available for those who use large amounts of water on their yards. The sewer charge is waived on the second meter. For further information on a second meter, please contact City Hall.

Bills are sent out quarterly around the 1st of the next quarter or annually on July 1 and are to be paid by the 20th of the month in order to receive a discount. If the account is not paid in full by the end of the month, the account is considered past due. If water is disconnected for any reason a \$25.00 reconnect fee along with a \$25.00 administrative fee will be added to the account balance.

You may elect to have your utility bill automatically deducted from your checking account. For further information, please contact City Hall.

If you move from Arnolds Park or to a different residence within the City, please call City Hall and make the necessary arrangements. If this is not done, all utilities will continue to be billed to you.

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage is collected on Mondays and Fridays beginning Memorial Day – Monday only beginning Labor Day. Garbage is collected on all holidays, except Christmas. Garbage collection begins at 7:00 A.M. Garbage bags may be purchased at City Hall, Great Spirits Wine & Liquor, The Boone Dock's, & Casey's in Arnolds Park, Buy-Rite in Milford, or Hy-Vee in Spirit Lake. Large bags are 10 @ \$6.50 – small bags are 10 @ \$4.00. The business may charge a handling fee.

RECYCLING

Curbside recycling collection days are the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. The City will provide you with two containers or you may use a container of your choice. There are recycle bins located on Dewey Street for cardboard, glass, tin, plastic, and newspaper, if you should miss the curbside collection.

Residential curbside items include:

1. Glass (Brown, Green & Clear): food containers only. Rinsed clean, discard lids, labels okay.
2. Tin: food containers only. Rinsed clean, discard lids, labels okay.
3. Plastic: check the bottom for recycling code (numbers 1, 2, or 3).
4. Cardboard: corrugated, pop cartons, cereal cartons, kleenex boxes – all flattened.
5. White & pastel paper: typing, computer, envelopes without windows or plastic removed, and other non-shiny white or pastel paper. Newspaper: anything received in the newspaper is recyclable as well as all paper not considered white paper. Paper back books & hardcover books with hardcover removed.

Above numbered items must be separated.

Do not recycle the following items:

- Waxed milk cartons, egg cartons, or Styrofoam
- Bleach bottles, anti-freeze, or oil containers
- Plastic bags – plastic grocery bags and bread bags are not currently recyclable
- Window glass, light bulbs, or ceramics

YARD WASTE & APPLIANCE/ELECTRONICS

Yard waste collection is on Tuesdays, weather permitting. Waste must be generated from property where collected. Place in City bags not exceeding 75 pounds. Cut branches in 4' lengths and bundle with a City bag attached. The City will also pick up appliances & electronics. You must purchase a tag for these items by contacting City Hall. Dickinson County has a recycling facility located at 2260 220th Street (A34) in Milford where you can dispose of all of the above items yourself. Please contact 712-338-2549 with any questions.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Before beginning any construction or moving in any structure, make sure to check with City Hall regarding any permits you may need. Also, before digging, call 24 hours in advance to Iowa One Call – 811.

SEVERE WEATHER
